AutoCAD not only uses various table-based methods of data storage and retrieval, it has a macro system for programming repetitive actions. Macro's can be used to do things such as draw objects, animate objects, or change settings. Autodesk has used AutoCAD for 2D drafting in two main forms: blueprints or print layout. Blueprints are made up of a series of objects that are set up and drawn using the table-based method for data storage. Drawing operations and settings are stored in the data table and are accessed by drawing objects. AutoCAD stores the entire blueprint on the computer hard drive. Paper layouts are stored on paper by using the various built-in paper size managers. This is used primarily in forms for construction projects and print layouts for printing and commercial publishing. There are special AutoCAD functions that assist in creating these layouts. These are discussed in more detail later in this tutorial. Autodesk also offers a version of AutoCAD called AutoCAD LT, which is available in both desktop and mobile versions. AutoCAD LT is designed to run on much less powerful hardware than AutoCAD and is used for creating prints, labels, and other types of print layouts. AutoCAD R16 AutoCAD uses a multi-level file system to store data. In AutoCAD, file names are created by appending a date-time stamp. The first level of the file system is the document, which is the folder where all of your data is stored. Each subfolder within the document represents a separate drawing. AutoCAD has three types of documents: Architecture, Engineering, and Drafting. For example, to open a drawing called ACAD_Sample.dwg in the drawing folder, the full path would be: Documents/Architecture/ACAD_Sample.dwg The full file path can be displayed by selecting Tools --> Options --> General and then choosing

Display Current Document Path from the Display drop-down menu. A complete list of the file structure can be found in the Help menu. The second level of the file system is the drawing. The folders and subfolders in a drawing are stored according to the drawing type that was used to create the drawing. Most drawings are organized by the company or company name that created the drawing. Some older drawings may be organized alphabetically. If a drawing contains 3-D objects,

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Grouping Visual LISP can be used to automate almost any aspect of the application. Macro language Visual LISP has a macro language, or "macro language". It is generally used for automation of complex drawing tasks and the support for Visual LISP macros is very similar to the Visual Basic for Applications. Docking AutoCAD provides a feature called docking, which allows the user to create or adjust AutoCAD templates and save them as templates. AutoCAD's Data/Application Templates are Docking Templates. The templates (which can be made for all common AutoCAD versions or one or more specific versions) can be installed on the local machine or on a remote machine via the network. Once the templates are installed on the user's computer, they can be run with each new project in AutoCAD. AutoCAD 2017 has more than 50 types of data templates and five types of application templates. Datasets The AutoCAD X and YMDD data formats, and a CSV-style file format are used for storing data. The FDS (Flexible Data Storage) and COM (Component Object Model) are two ways of creating data-saving files. Other data-saving formats include XSD, EDI, and XML. The 2D data stored in drawings can be imported into a spreadsheet for further processing and other applications. File format Each drawing format has its own XML-based file format. When an XML-based file is opened, the data type and the drawing format that created the file are displayed in the status bar. Datalog Datalog is a method of design and presentation of data. Each datalog file has a root element called datalog. Data can be stored within a datalog file in a hierarchical structure. Datalog files are mostly used in AutoCAD, which provides many features for design and editing of physical models. In addition to the applications mentioned above, and various programs of third-party developers, it is also a file format that is supported by 3ds Max and Maya. It is also supported by SolidWorks and Simcenter. Datalog is the data exchange format for Autodesk Alias' non-Autodesk software applications.
